- Authorship: Paul (around 61 A.D.)
- Recipient: The church in Philippi
- Major Theme: Joy
   (Greek words for 'joy' & 'rejoicing' used 16 times)
- Context: written while Paul was in prison and faced with the possibility of death.

"it's an attitude God's people adopt, not because of happy circumstances but because of their hope in God's love and promise" (Mackie 2017)




