## **Important verses**

# 1 Our role: Hab 2:4 "but the righteous shall live by his faith"

# 2 God's position: Hab 2:20 "But the LORD is in His holy temple."

## Key verse #1: Habakkuk 2:4

Habakkuk 2:4 "... But the righteous will live by his faith [in the true God]" (AMP)

- Romans 1:17 "The righteous will live by faith"
- Galatians 3:11"The righteous will live by faith"
- Hebrews 10:38 "The righteous will live by faith"

# **Meaning**

- Just/righteous = right before God; God-centred
- Live = everything in life; all of life
- Faith = attitude + action

## God's awareness: five "woes"

#### Abuse rather than use

- 1. (2:6) Money: rich by stealing, extortion or oppression
- 2. (2:9) Power: gain control by bringing down others
- 3. (2:12) Politics: using bribery & stand-over tactics
- 4. (2:15) Sex: forbidden sexual conduct
- 5. (2:19) Religion: idol worship

## Outlook on life

- 1. <u>High view</u>: "For My thoughts are not your thoughts nor are your ways My ways,' says the LORD." (Is 55:8-12) (MEV)
- **2.** Long view: "Then I went into your sanctuary, O God, and I finally understood the destiny of the wicked" (Psalm 73:17) (NLT)
- 3. Short view: "But we live by faith, not by what we see." (2 Cor 5:7) (CEV)
- 4. <u>Ultimate view</u>: "God may kill me, but still I will trust him." (Job 13:15) (CEV)

Why? God is in His temple; still in control
