But you will receive power when the Holy Spirit comes on you; and you will be my witnesses in Jerusalem, and in all Judea and Samaria, and to the ends of the earth.

What is the ends of the earth?

- This exact phrase appears 46x in the scriptures.
- A similar phrase "the ends of the world" also occurs twice (2x) in Ps 19:4
 & Rom 10:18

Moses: FAR AWAY NATIONS

Deut 28:49 The Lord will bring a nation against you from far away, from the ends of the earth, like an eagle swooping down, a nation whose language you will not understand,

Deut 33:17 In majesty he is like a firstborn bull; his horns are the horns of a wild ox. With them he will gore the nations, even those at the ends of the earth...

Hannah: THE WHOLE EARTH

1 Sam 2:10: those who oppose the Lord will be broken. The Most High will thunder from heaven; the Lord will judge the ends of the earth. "He will give strength to his king and exalt the horn of his anointed."

Job/Elihu: EVERYWHERE

Job 28:24 for he views the ends of the earth and sees everything under the heavens.

Job 37:3 He unleashes his lightning beneath the whole heaven and sends it to the ends of the earth.

Psalmist(s): ENTIRE WORLD

Psa 22:27 All the ends of the earth will remember and turn to the Lord, and all the families of the nations will bow down before him,

Psa 48:10 Like your name, O God, your praise reaches to the ends of the earth; your right hand is filled with righteousness.

Psa 65:5 You answer us with awesome and righteous deeds, God our Savior, the hope of all the ends of the earth and of the farthest seas,

Psa 98:3 He has remembered his love and his faithfulness to Israel; all the ends of the earth have seen the salvation of our God.

Isaiah: DISTANT NATIONS, GENTILES EVERYWHERE

Isa 5:26 He lifts up a banner for the distant nations, he whistles for those at the ends of the earth. Here they come, swiftly and speedily!

Isa 49:6 he says: "It is too small a thing for you to be my servant to restore the tribes of Jacob and bring back those of Israel I have kept. I will also make you a light for the Gentiles, that my salvation may reach to the ends of the earth."

Be Careful how you live – Eph 5:8-20

⁸ For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord. Live as children of light ⁹ (for the fruit of the light consists in all goodness, righteousness and truth) ¹⁰ and find out what pleases the Lord.

¹¹ Have nothing to do with the fruitless deeds of darkness, but rather expose them. ¹² It is shameful even to mention what the disobedient do in secret. ¹³ But everything exposed by the light becomes visible—and everything that is illuminated becomes a light. ¹⁴ This is why it is said:

"Wake up, sleeper, rise from the dead, and Christ will shine on you."

Be Careful how you live – Eph 5:8-20

15 Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, 16 making the most of every opportunity, because the days are evil. Therefore do not be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is. 18 Do not get drunk on wine, which leads to debauchery. Instead, be filled with the Spirit, 19 speaking to one another with psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit. Sing and make music from your heart to the Lord, 20 always giving thanks to God the Father for everything, in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.
