
- ☐ The fear of the LORD is the beginning of knowledge & wisdom.

WISDOM FOR FAMILIES



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- □ Remember we are given the freedom to choose to walk in the way of God's wisdom or instead seek the foolishness of sin.
- ☐ So there exists a tension between:
  - the way God designed the world (to be)
  - the way the world is (right now).

### Proverbs 22:6

Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it.

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#### PRINCIPLE 1: TEACH THEM

**Proverbs 6:20-23** 

20 My son, keep your father's command and do not forsake your mother's teaching.

21 Bind them always on your heart; fasten them around your neck.

22 When you walk, they will guide you; when you sleep, they will watch over you; when you awake, they will speak to you.

23 For this command is a lamp, this teaching is a light, and correction and instruction are the way to life,

#### PRINCIPLE 1: TEACH THEM

(Proverbs 22:6; Proverbs 6:20-23)

- □ Parents Don't try to outsource this completely!
- □ Remember this is YOUR primary responsibility to teach and train YOUR children in the way they should go.

#### PRINCIPLE 1: TEACH THEM

#### **HOW MIGHT WE TEACH THEM? Deuteronomy 6:6-9**

<sup>6</sup> These commandments that I give you today are to be on your hearts. <sup>7</sup> Impress them on your children. Talk about them when you sit at home and when you walk along the road, when you lie down and when you get up. <sup>8</sup> Tie them as symbols on your hands and bind them on your foreheads. <sup>9</sup> Write them on the doorframes of your houses and on your gates.

### PRINCIPLE 1: TEACH THEM

#### HOW MIGHT WE TEACH THEM? 2 Timothy 3:16-17

<sup>16</sup> All Scripture is God-breathed and is useful for teaching, rebuking, correcting and training in righteousness, <sup>17</sup> so that the servant of God may be thoroughly equipped for every good work.

PRINCIPLE 1: TEACH THEM

HOW MIGHT WE TEACH THEM?

(Deuteronomy 6:6-9; 2 Timothy 3:16-17)

- You could start by attaching a time of Bible reading and prayer to another habit you do each day already.
- ☐ The key is to make it a natural part of your family rhythm.

My son, give me your heart,

and let your eyes observe my ways.

- ☐ Remember that consistency & integrity are of vital importance.


#### PRINCIPLE 3: CORRECT THEM

Discipline your children, and they will give you peace; they will bring you the delights you desire.

#### PRINCIPLE 3: CORRECT THEM

**Proverbs 29:17**;

#### Proverbs 13:24

Whoever spares the rod hates their children, but the one who loves their children is careful to discipline them.

#### PRINCIPLE 3: CORRECT THEM

**Proverbs 29:17; Proverbs 13:24;** 

#### <u>Proverbs 22:15</u> (ESV);

Folly is bound up in the heart of a child, but the rod of discipline drives it far from him.

#### PRINCIPLE 3: CORRECT THEM

- ☐ Children need boundaries for healthy development.
- ☐ Correction is necessary because of our foolishness and sin.
- □ Parents who love their children and want what's best for them will correct (discipline) them when they seek to go astray.
- ☐ Failing to discipline our children is unloving.

#### PRINCIPLE 3: CORRECT THEM

Proverbs 29:17; Proverbs 13:24; Proverbs 22:15 (ESV);

#### **Proverbs 23:13-14**

Do not withhold discipline from a child;

if you punish them with the rod, they will not die.

Punish them with the rod

and save them from death.

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- ☐ Failing to discipline our children is unloving.
- ☐ The aim of correction is to help our kids to fear the Lord and to live for Him.
- □ Parents should bring correction in love rather than out of anger or frustration.

### PRINCIPLE 1: HEAR THEM (Listen to your Parents)

#### **Proverbs 8:32-34a**

- <sup>32</sup> "Now then, my children, listen to me; blessed are those who keep my ways.
- <sup>33</sup> Listen to my instruction and be wise; do not disregard it.
- 34 Blessed are those who listen to me,

PRINCIPLE 2: HEED THEM (Obey your Parents)

Proverbs 15:5 (ESV)

A fool despises his father's instruction,

but whoever heeds reproof is prudent.

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Proverbs 15:5 (ESV)

A fool despises his father's instruction,

but whoever heeds reproof (takes correction) is prudent (becomes wise).

Children, obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.

Children, obey your parents in everything, for this pleases the Lord.

PRINCIPLE 3: HONOUR THEM (Honour your

Parents)

Proverbs 20:20 (NIV)

If someone curses their father or mother, their lamp will be snuffed out in pitch darkness.

### PRINCIPLE 3: HONOUR THEM (Honour your Parents)

Proverbs 20:20 (NIV)

Ephesians 6:2-3

<sup>2</sup>"Honor your father and mother"—which is the first commandment with a promise— <sup>3</sup>"so that it may go well with you and that you may enjoy long life on the earth." (cf. Deut 20:12)

### PRINCIPLE 3: HONOUR THEM (Honour your Parents)

- Proverbs 20:20; Ephesians 6:2-3 (Cf. Deuteronomy 20:12)
- ☐ How we honour our earthly parents can affect our destiny.
- ☐ If we can't honour the parents we CAN see, we may be less likely to honour our Heavenly Father we CAN'T see.
- ☐ God is the one (perfect) father from whom every family on earth derives its name. (Ephesians 3:13-14)
