

- ☐ Australian HR Survey results...
- 45% of all workers dissatisfied with their current job.
- 67% already looking (or planning to look) for a new job this year. (Seeking better pay, conditions etc.)
- Average length in one job = 3.3 years.
- 20% of workers have more than 4 weeks annual leave accrued.
- A significant portion of respondents admit to working after hours and on weekends. (some checking work emails hourly).
