

**John 1:43-51 (NLT)**

<sup>43</sup> The next day Jesus decided to go to Galilee. He found Philip and said to him, “Come, follow me.” <sup>44</sup> Philip was from Bethsaida, Andrew and Peter’s hometown. <sup>45</sup> Philip went to look for **Nathanael** and told him, “We have found the very person Moses and the prophets wrote about! His name is Jesus, the son of Joseph from Nazareth.”

<sup>46</sup> “Nazareth!” exclaimed Nathanael. “Can anything good come from Nazareth?”  
“Come and see for yourself,” Philip replied.

<sup>47</sup> As they approached, Jesus said, “Now here is a genuine son of Israel—a man of complete integrity.”
