
### Thank God for 2024!

1 Thessalonians 5:16-18



### 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 (ESV)

<sup>16</sup> Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing, <sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you.

### Paul is addressing the CHURCH (v.16-19)

<sup>16</sup> (as a church) Rejoice always, <sup>17</sup> (as a church) pray without ceasing, <sup>18</sup> (as a church) give thanks in all circumstances; for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus for you (the church).

These three key elements (Joy, Prayer & Thanksgiving) should be evident among God's people as we gather each week!

#### **Three KEY ELEMENTS of our worship (v.16-18)**

- 1. There should be joy (rejoicing) in our gathering together as God's people.
- 2. Persistent (constant) Prayer should ne a natural part of our fellowship.
- 3. We should be thankful to God (in all circumstances) for what He has done.

# 1. There should be JOY (rejoicing) in our gathering together as God's people. (v.16)

<sup>16</sup> Rejoice always,

How can we rejoice <u>always</u>?

Within the church there should be constant joy because we know that we are the redeemed, chosen people of God whom He has promised will inherit eternal life!

#### **Matthew 9:14-15 (ESV)**

<sup>14</sup> Then the disciples of John came to him, saying, "Why do we and the Pharisees fast, but your disciples do not fast?" <sup>15</sup> And Jesus said to them, "Can the wedding guests mourn as long as the bridegroom is with them? The days will come when the bridegroom is taken away from them, and then they will fast.

# 1. There should be JOY (rejoicing) in our gathering together as God's people. (v.16)

- Because we are the people of God.
- Because Jesus is with us always. (Matthew 5:14-15; Matthew 28:20)

# 2. Persistent (constant) PRAYER should be a natural part of our fellowship. (v.17)

<sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing

How can we pray without ceasing?

- None of us can live up to this (as individuals).
- When we view this through the lens of the gathered body (the church) this is more possible for us.

# 2. Persistent (constant) PRAYER should be a natural part of our fellowship. (v.17)

<sup>17</sup> pray without ceasing

How can we pray without ceasing?

- None of us can live up to this (as individuals).
- Together (as the church) this is made possible for us.
- It is good to know that it's not just up to you or me.

# 3. We are to be THANKFUL in all circumstances for what God has done (and is doing) among us. (v.18a).

<sup>18</sup> give thanks in all circumstances

- It's hard to be thankful if we never pause long enough to reflect on what God has done.
- We have a lot to thank God for in 2024.

LET'S PAUSE AND GIVE THANKS TO HIM TODAY!

- 1. New life in Christ Jesus.
- Praise God for bringing people from darkness to light, from death to life.
- Give thanks for His gift of eternal life in Christ Jesus.
- Remember this is His work, not ours!


- 2. Those who have **encouraged us** in our walk with the Lord.


